Helping Kids Who Really Need It: Grants funded by the Delta Pilots Charitable Fund (DPCF) this week: \$19,780. (We do this three times a year, and do major projects every few years.)

*Good done by the DPCF this week:* Limitless. Pilot donations supported programs from inner-city kids' camps to the Juvenile Diabetes Research Fund (JDRF). Join us.

**The Trip Mix - and Staffing:** Crew Resources works with the Rotation Construction Committee (RCC) - when credit and staffing allow - to accommodate the pilot group's quality of life desires, in regard to trip mix. However, there will be periods of peak flying that provide less flexibility for Crew Resources to invest in this effort. This reduced flexibility, especially for the M88 and 320 categories, was reflected in the July and August bid packages. The situation is improving and we should see a return to a more favorable trip mix as early as the September bid period.

We will continue to monitor the bid packages to ensure PWA compliance and, when staffing permits, we will work with Crew Resources to obtain a more improved trip mix for the pilot group.
