Sleep Apnea: ALPA is fully aware of the controversial statements that have been made by the FAA regarding testing for obstructive sleep apnea. We are very concerned that the agency has taken this action without thoroughly discussing and addressing the matter first with stakeholders. We are presently engaging the FAA and airlines in an effort to slow this process down and give ALPA and other stakeholders the opportunity to work with the agency to develop a data-driven approach to this particular medical condition that satisfies the concerns of all affected parties. We will keep the membership informed of our progress in this matter via FastRead and other means.

Flexible Spending Account Rollover: The IRS announced a change to the "Use It or Lose It" policy for healthcare FSAs. They will now allow carryover up to \$500 of unused FSA dollars for use in the next year. This applies to both the full purpose and limited purpose FSAs. Delta will implement this change immediately. If you are unable to use all of your current FSA dollars by the end of 2013, up to \$500 will automatically carryover for use in 2014. This is in addition to your 2014 Healthcare FSA election. During the 2014 Benefit Enrollment period from now through November 27, you may still elect to contribute up to \$2,500 to your 2014 Healthcare FSA. The maximum amount you can have in your Healthcare FSA for 2014 is now increased to \$3,000 - the maximum election of \$2,500 plus \$500 in carryover. This rule will also apply in future years. If you have already completed your 2014 enrollment, you may want to reconsider your healthcare FSA elections based on this new carryover provision. You still have until the enrollment deadline on November 27 to make any additional changes to your elections.

Special MEC Meeting: The Delta MEC will hold a special MEC meeting Monday, December 9th at the Hilton Atlanta Airport, 1031 Virginia Avenue, Atlanta. It is scheduled as a two day meeting.

Master Chairman Election: An election for the Delta MEC Master Chairman will take place at the December 9- 10 Special MEC meeting in Atlanta. The term begins immediately following the election through December 2014. If you are interested in running for this position, please contact your LEC representative or call the MEC office at 1-800-USA-ALPA. The MEC will cover a candidate's expenses at the meeting, but not flight pay loss.

Benefits Open Enrollment: Delta open enrollment for benefits began Wed., November 6 and will end at 11:59pm, Wed., November 27. Roth BrokerageLink Coming In December: Fidelity is in the process of splitting BrokerageLink into Roth and non-Roth accounts for those who participate in BrokerageLink in the Delta Pilots Savings Plan. You are reminded that there will be a blackout window on certain transactions from December 4th through December 11th.
