**Virgin Atlantic:** The Negotiating Committee met with their Virgin Atlantic (BALPA) counterparts this week for discussions related to the JV.

**DOJ and EC Give Blessing:** Yesterday, the European Commission and the US Department of Justice gave their approval for Delta's purchase of a 49 percent share of Virgin Atlantic. While this decision allows the corporate transaction to occur, the Delta-Virgin joint venture must still pass the scrutiny of the U.S. Department of Transportation. That approval process can take several months and a decision is anticipated in the fall.

**TOT Report:** From September 2012 through February 2013, teams from Flight Operations and ALPA met to discuss possible process improvements in areas relating to training and standards. The results are available in the <u>Training Optimization Team II Report and Recommendations</u> posted on the Delta MEC website under Training Committee. **ASAP:** The CASC team and FltOps are working together to improve "safety reporting culture." CLCP phone follow-ups and formal training prescriptions are down sharply over the past few months, and the feedback from pilots who have been contacted has been consistently positive.

Trust ASAP. The information is valuable, you will be protected from evaluation or discipline (company or FAA), and while ERC-prescribed training is unlikely, it is normally a positive experience if it does occur.

**Training Hotel Security:** As a general reminder, be mindful of your surroundings while staying at any of the training hotels on Virginia Avenue. To the extent possible, try to park vehicles in well-lit areas and as close to the hotel as possible. Fill out an FCR to report any issues to the company.

**Ex-Im Bank Ruling:** The Air Line Pilots Association, Int'l (ALPA) hailed a federal appeals court decision to uphold a legal challenge by ALPA and Delta Air Lines maintaining that the U.S. Export-Import Bank had failed to meet its legal obligation to evaluate the potential effect on U.S. airlines and U.S. jobs before making loan guarantees to Air India for the purchase of wide-body aircraft.

ALPA does not expect the Export-Import Bank to unilaterally disarm in the wide-body aircraft subsidy back-and-forth with Europe, however, both sides have an incentive to wind this financing down. See: Leveling the Playing Field For U.S. Airlines and Their Employees
