FFDO Funding Cut Proposed: <u>Tell Congress to maintain FFDO Funding</u>. The President's FY2014 budget proposal cuts *all* funding for the program. ALPA is fighting this issue and others. There are three active Calls To Action. All Delta pilots need to take a few minutes to complete them.
