The SRH will be a "live document," updated as needed.

Delta Pilots Medical Plan: One media outlet has reported Delta intends to scrap the Delta Pilots Medical Plan (DPMP) due to it being subject to the "Cadillac Tax". This rumor is false and there are no intentions or negotiations to modify the DPMP. Furthermore, the current DPMP is not impacted by the Cadillac Tax rules contained in the Affordable Care Act.

ALPA Anniversary Pins: Please note that ALPA anniversary pins are based on the date your original membership application was approved. In the majority of cases the join date is very close to the hire date; however, delays in application approval or the date ALPA became the collective bargaining agent for a carrier must be considered.

Anniversary pins are issued in five year increments beginning at year ten. The DAL MEC requested that the anniversary pin mailed to you represent your total years of membership with the Association as of December 31, 2013. If you have not yet reached a milestone anniversary, you were provided with the pin that most closely corresponds to your join date on record.
