Delta Health Rewards Credit Deadline: September 30th is the deadline to receive credits under the Delta Health Rewards Program. See the "My Self Service" page on DeltaNet. If you were an active pilot on 3/31/2013 or will be on 9/30/2013, you will automatically receive Delta Health Rewards points for an annual physical exam. For inactive pilots and spouses, take a Provider Notification Form to your annual physical exam and ask the provider to complete and return it (available on DeltaNet>Employee Connection>Benefit Forms). Tobacco users, wanting to quit, can enroll in the Delta Health Direct quit tobacco program ASAP to meet the September 30 deadline.

Draw The Line Here: ALPA has launched an informational web site as part of a collaborative educational campaign on the Abu Dhabi Customs and Border Protection Facility proposal. The Fight is (Still) On: FFDO Funding and Abu Dhabi: Thanks to thousands of ALPA pilot partisans, ALPA-PAC, and the efforts of ALPA's Aviation Security Committee, pilot volunteers, and Government Affairs staff, the House of Representatives approved a Homeland Security Appropriations bill that included two amendments: funding for the FFDO program for fiscal year 2014 and blocking taxpayer funding of the Abu Dhabi Pre-Clearance Facility. Our <u>efforts on the Hill are paying off</u>. There are three active <u>Calls To Action</u>. We must <u>continue to tell Congress about our issues</u> as we now focus on the Senate.
