American-US Airways Merger— On Wednesday, February 13, American and US Airways announced their merger. The Delta MEC is studying the developing transaction and will prepare for any eventuality or opportunity that may present itself.

OptumRx Issues— Many pilots are reporting having issues with the transition to OptumRx. If you are one of them and need assistance in getting prescription refills, enrolling various family members or anything related to this transition, please contact the Delta MEC R&I senior benefits specialist. If you paid out of pocket for a prescription, there is a claim form that can be submitted for reimbursement. Please email your issues or request for claim form to the senior benefits specialist at Karen.browne@alpa.org so that she can escalate them to Delta for resolution.

**ALPA Dues, DPMA and Profit Sharing**— As per Section 3 A. of Article IX of the ALPA Constitution and By-Laws, income including profit sharing is subject to dues. Those dues were deducted accordingly.

However, those pilots who opted to put 90-100 percent of the profit sharing into their 401k will have the appropriate dues deducted from the February 15th paycheck.

DPMA section 1(a) of Article VI of the DPMA plan states that source of funds to operate the plan be made through payroll deductions. Those members who opted to put 90-100 percent of the profit sharing into their 401k will have the appropriate DPMA contributions deducted from February 15th paycheck.

Note that profit sharing income is also subject to FICA taxes, regardless of whether it is contributed to the 401(k). If you have any questions please contact the Delta Employee Service Center at 1-800-MY-DELTA.

Lastly, all pilots are eligible to receive Delta DC/DPSP employer contributions based on their profit sharing payout. However, Delta will make the deposit to Fidelity for both the profit sharing and your regular mid-month pay on February 15th, and the aggregate contributions for both will be reflected on your February 15th pay stub.

Call-to-Action — Contact Congress today to urge support for the Safe Skies Act of 2013. This helps to achieve one level of safety for passenger and cargo aviation. Last year's Congress let this issue go but we will not. Delta pilots should be concerned at the White House's continued interest in allowing U.S. Customs Pre-clearance facility in Abu Dhabi. Tell the President your concerns on this issue. For family and friends who may want to contact the White House in opposition to the US CBP facility in the UAE, use Contact the White House. As a result of pilot input, ALPA has sponsored POPVOX for your family, neighbors and friends who support our Pilot Partisan issues to contact Congress. Spread the word. When enough people speak the Hill begins to listen.
