*GUM Hotel Update* - Effective today, crews will be moved out of the Royal Orchid Hotel in Guam. The Royal Orchid was deemed unsuitable during a no-notice site inspection on Wednesday. Crews will be moved to the Aurora Hotel from March 1-5. Stand by for more information once Delta finalizes a contract going forward.
