FFDO Funding Cut Proposed: <u>Tell Congress to maintain FFDO Funding</u>. The President's FY2014 budget proposal cuts *all* funding for the program. ALPA is fighting this issue and others. There are three active <u>Calls To Action</u>. All Delta pilots need to take a few minutes to complete them.

Council Bypass: Following an Advanced Entitlement many pilots change bases and therefore their ALPA affiliation could change. As per the Delta MEC policy manual, council affiliation is normally determined by a pilot's base. A member may affiliate with a council at his base or with the council nearest his company home of record (council bypass). If the member is a seniority list instructor then his default affiliation will be with the council that matches his status (i.e. council 48).
