Known Crew Member at DFW: A new access point opened this past Monday in Terminal E at DFW. According to the airport's website, Alaska, Delta, Spirit and United have operations out of that terminal. ALPA has identified Terminal A as another recommended site for KCM at DFW to benefit additional ALPA carriers. TSA is researching that possibility. More information on KCM will be provided as it becomes available.

Pinnacle Airlines renamed "Endeavor": The airline formerly known as "Pinnacle" is now "Endeavor Airlines", and the pilots' IDs will begin to reflect that change over the next few weeks through October. The Jumpseat/Flow back agreement chart on DeltaNet will be revised in the future to reflect this change.

Jumpseat Priority Reminder: Since Endeavor Airlines is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Delta, jumpseat priority for pilots of both airlines is reciprocally elevated above other airlines. Questions? <u>dalmecjumpseat@alpa.org</u> . Issues? JSAP and FCR.

Colorado Recovering: The Delta Pilot Network reached out to 181 Delta pilots in harm's way last weekend, offering the MEC's resources including the Furlough/Emergency Relief Fund, Pilot Assistance Network (PAN), and Scheduling and Contract Admin. If you, or anyone you know, require help, please contact us so you can use the Delta pilots' resources.

PilotBlast Text Subscription: Are you receiving texts for a category you no longer fly? If you have recently changed categories or phone numbers and are a PilotBlast subscriber, please remember to update your PilotBlast preferences to reflect your new information. Don't lose \$600 - Delta Health Rewards Credit Deadline: As a reminder of the September 30th deadline for completion of the tasks under the Delta Health Rewards program, as of September 6th, only 30% of pilots had completed all three tasks, and only 12% of spouses had. If you intend to be a participant in the Diamond or Ruby plans in 2014, the deductibles will be increasing, and if you intend to be a participant in the Gold or Silver HRA plans in 2014, the HRA dollars will be reduced. To offset these changes, ensure you complete the Delta Health Rewards items. It could be a \$600 mistake if you don't.

See the "My Self Service" page on DeltaNet. If you are an active pilot on 3/31/2013 and/or 9/30/2013, you will automatically receive Delta Health Rewards points for an annual physical exam.

Inactive pilots and spouses: Take a Provider Notification Form to your annual physical exam and ask the provider to complete and return the form (available on the Benefit Forms page, Employee Connection, DeltaNet).
