**Risk-Based Security:** ALPA supports the TSA's continuing "risk based security" approach. Emotions are not and should not be a factor in evaluating this program. In risk-based security, the effort is focused on people, places and things posing a significant threat. This unemotional analysis allows pilots to be prescreened for security and is the cornerstone of the "trusted agent" philosophy that permits the KCM, CASS, FFDO, FAM and LEO programs to exist. Risk based analysis acknowledges that pilots are not a significant threat.

Objects are also subject to risk analysis. The TSA determines which objects are threats and concentrates on them, not on symbols. The April 25th screening changes reflect valid risk analysis, and align TSA policy with long-established ICAO and European security rules. With millions of passengers flown, no incidents involving the newly allowed items have occurred.

Beijing Air Quality: Air Crew and Passenger Health Services issued an air quality alert for higher than normal pollutant levels in Beijing. To view the notice, which includes preventive action steps, log into DeltaNet and select "Travel Health Alerts."

FAA 737 Simulator Study: The FAA is conducting a simulator study in OKC April 15-19. Current and qualified B-737NG Captains and F/O's are needed. This non-jeopardy experience does not require any advance study or preparation. Compensation is \$400 daily, plus \$99 per diem and hotel reimbursement. If driving your personal vehicle, you will be reimbursed at the government mileage rate. LPFSA Coinsurance Claims: For the 996 participants who have a Limited Purpose Flexible Spending Account in conjunction with either the Diamond or Ruby Account Based Health plans, it has come to our attention that United Health Care may have erroneously told participants that the 10 percent coinsurance amount could not be reimbursed through the LPFSA. An audit of the records revealed only two participants who had additional claims to reprocess. However, we urge ALL LPFSA participants to

take a careful look at their FSA account detail to ensure that all 10 percent coinsurance claims have been processed as the March 31st deadline for filling for FSA claims occurs this weekend. If you have claims, they can be faxed to 915-231-1709 or Toll Free to 866-262-6354.

**2012 FSA Submission Deadline**: UHC must receive your submission of an FSA claim form for reimbursement from a Dependent Care Flexible Spending Account, Healthcare Flexible Spending Account or Limited Purpose Flexible Spending Account by March 31, 2013. For further details click here.

**1040X Filing Deadline**: If you made an IRA contribution under the provisions of the FAA Modernization and Reform Act of 2012, please be advised that the deadline for filing your federal amended tax return, IRS Form 1040X, is April 15, 2013. Please review *R&I Report 13-01* for further guidance.

Two Calls-to-Action - Get involved!: Contact Congress today to urge support for the Safe Skies Act of 2013. This helps to achieve one level of safety for passenger and cargo aviation. Delta pilots should also be concerned the White House has continued interest in allowing U.S. Customs Pre-clearance facility in Abu Dhabi. Tell the President your concerns on this issue.
