ASAP Update: "your report left open while Flight Safety gathers further background information." Pilots who have submitted ASAP reports often receive an email from Flight Safety containing this phrase after their report has initially been reviewed by the ERC. This is not an indication of a problem. Almost without exception, this message merely indicates that the ERC/FAA wishes to hold the report open to ensure no ATC paperwork (pilot deviation) exists that would affect the ERC's treatment of the event. By three-party agreement, the FAA is granted ten business days to locate/produce filed deviation reports, so many potential deviations are held open an extra week to honor this agreement.

All pilots should also be aware that the current budget impasse is affecting the ASAP program. With minimal FAA personnel reporting to work, the ERC is at a standstill and the number of reports awaiting review is growing. The company and ALPA are working together to minimize this slowdown, but delays in ASAP report closure/results are inevitable.

Migration of iALPA: We are upgrading iALPA to make it more user friendly and more accessible to our pilots.
